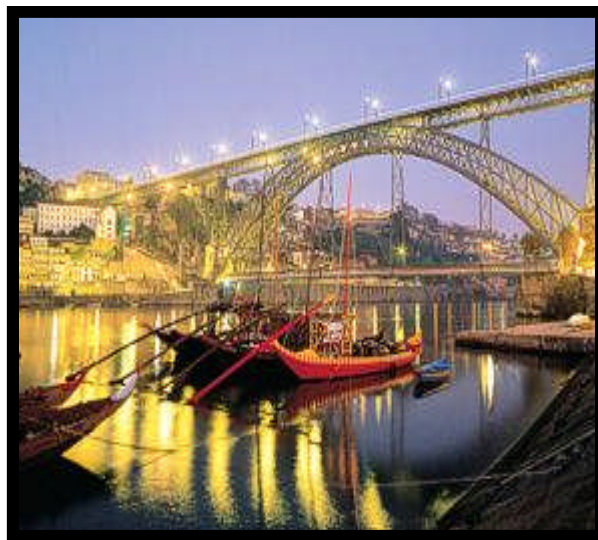

Itinerary in brief

- Oct 4 Overnight flight Philadelphia to Lisbon
- Oct 5 **Lisbon**- Panoramic tour of the city. Mass at St. Anthony's Church. Group dinner and Fado performance.
- Oct 6 **Lisbon**- Tour Belem area of the city; Jeronimos Monastery; St. Roque Church & Museum the first Jesuit church in Portugal. Mass at St. Roque's
- Oct 7 **Evora**- Site of first Jesuit seminary in Portugal with structures dating to the 2nd century. Walking tour. Mass- St. Francis Church. Group dinner.
- Oct 8 **Santarem / Alcobaca** -Cathedral of Santarem originally built for the Jesuits as a seminary. Alcobaca- Cistercian Abbey of Santa Maria. Mass in Alcobaca.
- Oct 9 **Fatima**—A day in Fatima with visits to the Basilica where we will celebrate Mass, Chapel of Apparitions and Shrine. Evening candle lighting & procession.
- Oct 10 **Tomar / Coimbra**—Convento de Cristo built by Knights Templar. 15th century synagogue and museum. Coimbra- University founded by the Jesuits. Mass - New Cathedral.
- Oct 11 **Coimbra**-continue visit to this historic town- walking tour of old Jewish quarter. Mass- Capela Sao Miquel; Tour the Biblioteca Joanina.
- Oct 12 **Porto**- Second city of Portugal on the banks of the Douro river. Visit cathedral & cloisters, Mass- Church of St. Francis; Boat ride on Douro River. Port tasting.
- Oct 13 **Braga / Santiago de Compostela**-Braga, the oldest city in Portugal; Bom Jesus do Monte pilgrimage site. Arrive Santiago- tour Barrio Antiguo, visit cathedral; Mass.
- Oct 14 **Santiago de Compostela / Porto** A day on the Camino de Santiago with Mass. Evening return to Porto-group farewell dinner..
- Oct 15 Flight from Porto—Lisbon— Philadelphia
