

## Itinerary cont'd.

- October 12      **Porto**- Portugal's second biggest city. Visit the cathedral and its spectacular gothic cloisters. Visit the opulent Church of St. Francis- celebrate Mass. Boat ride on the Douro River. Port wine tasting.
- October 13      **Braga**- the oldest Portuguese city. Visit Bom Jesus de Monte pilgrimage site. The Cathedral- rich mix of architectural and artistic styles. St. Paul Church- built by the Jesuits- 16th century.  
Travel on to **Santiago de Compostela**- famous pilgrimage site and home to the Cathedral that is the end of the Camino de Santiago- pilgrim trail that extends from Switzerland across Europe to this point in Northwestern Spain where St. James the Apostle is said to be buried beneath the altar. Mass in the Cathedral. Walk around the Barrio Antigo. Overnight in Santiago.
- October 14      Walk on the Camino de **Santiago**. Mass in a chapel en route. Spend most of the day in Santiago. Leave early evening for **Porto**. Group farewell dinner in Vila Nova de Gaia across the river from Porto. Overnight in Porto.
- October 15      Fly Porto-Lisbon- Philadelphia
